# **PRIVACY POLICY (Website)**

This website is operated by Congleton Garden Machinery. We take you privacy very seriously therefore we urge you to read this policy very carefully because it contains important information about us and:

the personal information we collect about you, our users what we do with your information, and who your information may be shared with.

#### Who we are

Congleton Garden Machinery ("we" or "us") are a data controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 (i.e. we are responsible for, and control the processing of, your personal information).

#### Information we collect

#### How we use the information we collect

We collect information about our users for the following purposes:

Identify you and manage any accounts you hold with us; process your order; deliver your order; make courtesy calls regarding your purchases.

#### Who your information may be shared with

We may share your information with:

Law enforcement agencies in connection with any investigation to help prevent unlawful activity

#### Marketing

We would like to send you information about products, services, offers, competitions and our business which may be of interest to you. Such information could be sent by post, email or telephone.

We will ask whether you would like us to send you marketing messages on the first occasion that you provide any relevant contact information (i.e. on purchase, entering a competition, etc.) If you do opt in to receive such marketing from us you can opt out at any time (see "what rights do you have" below for further information). If you have any queries about how to opt out, or if you are receiving messages you do not want you can contact us using the details provided below.

## **Keeping your information secure**

We will use technological and organisation measures to keep your information secure. These measures may include the following examples:

User account access is controlled by a unique username and password; All data is stored on secure servers; Payment details are encrypted.

However, while we will use all reasonable efforts to secure you personal data, in using the site you acknowledge that the use of the internet is not entirely secure and for this reason we cannot guarantee the security or integrity of any personal data that is transferred from your or to you via the internet. If you have any particular concerns about your information, please contact us using the details below.

## What rights do you have?

You can request a copy of your information

You can request a copy of your information which we hold (this is known as a subject access request). If you would like a copy of it, please:

- Email, call or write to us (using the contact details below)
- Let us have proof of your identify and address (a copy of your driving licence or passport and a recent utility or credit card bill) and

• Let us know the information you want a copy of, including any account or reference numbers, if you have them

## Right to correct any mistakes in your information

You can request us to correct any mistakes in your information which we hold free of charge. If you would like to do this please:

- Contact us using the contact details below
- Let us have enough information to identify you (e.g. name, address etc), and
- Let us know the information that is incorrect and what it should be replaced with.

## Right to ask us to stop contacting you with direct marketing

You can ask us to stop contacting you for direct marketing purposes. If you would like to do this, please:

- Let us have proof of your identify and address (a copy of your driving licence or passport and a recent utility or credit card bill) and
- Let us know what method of contact you are not happy with if you are unhappy with certain ways of contacting you only (for example, you may be happy for us to contact you by email but not by telephone)
